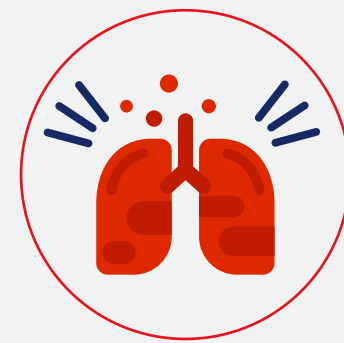

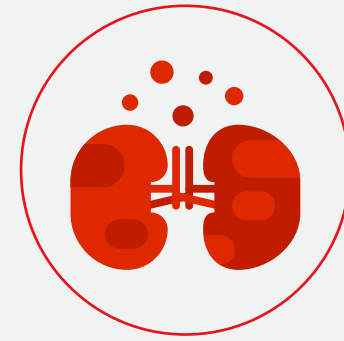

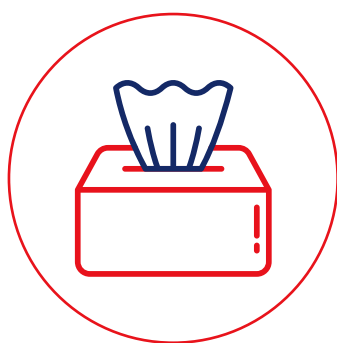


MAINTAIN GOOD HYGIENE HABITS AT ALL TIMES
